As per Society Registration act the field area is entire Chhattisgarh. However, ASM is currently working in following clusters of villages in Chhattisgarh:

- --30 villages spread out in 13 G.Ps in Bodla block in Kabirdham district, Chhattisgarh
- --57 villages spread out in 19 in G.Ps in Pandariya block, Kabirdham district, Chhattisgarh
- --20 villages spread out in 8 G.Ps in Korba block in district, Chhattisgarh
- --40 villages spread out in 16 G.Ps in Dharamjaigarh block in Raigarh district, Chhattisgarh
- --55 villages spread out in 17 G.Ps in Bhanupratapur block in kanker district in Chhattisgarh

MAJOR ACTIVITIES:

Adiwasi Samta Manch (ASM) is working on capacitating marginalized communities to secure their basic rights and entitlements (water, education, health, shelter, skill development etc) and rights under pro poor Acts (MNREGA and Forest Rights Act) and welfare schemes and dignity. It is also working on the issue of gender rights of indigenous women and empowering them through Self Help Groups (on traditional agriculture produce and Non Timber Forest Produce) & capacity building programs. It is also working on the theme of environmental justice, biodiversity conservation and promotion and protection of traditional livelihood practices and culture. ASM is also engaged in improving education system for most underprivileged children and securing rights for Persons with Disabilities under PWD Act.

ACTIVITIES ON ADIVASI DEVELOPMENT, THEIR FOREST LIFE AND LIVELIHOOD:

ASM is working for operationalizing Forest Rights Act .It is focusing on IFR as well as Community Forest Rights. Apart from facilitating, capacitating community members in application process and people centred advocacy on FRA it is also supporting communities in making forest management plans and is engaged in capacitating Van Prabhandhan Samities/Forest Management committees. It is also working on the theme of biodiversity conservation and promotion and protection of traditional livelihood practices and culture. It is also working towards strengthening SHGs based on MFP.
